Principal's Corner

Dear Parents,

Every six years, St. Ann School completes a Self-Study to submit to the Wisconsin Religious and Independent Schools Association (WRISA) for re-accreditation. Once completed, our school is then visited by a team of Diocesan principals and teachers who have been trained in the Accreditation Evaluation process. While here, they spend their time reviewing our Self-Study documentation and getting to know our school on a more personal level.

Last school year, the staff worked very hard to complete this Self-Study process, and next week, March 17 and 18, the WRISA Visiting Team will conduct their review. They will observe the various aspects of our school day, conduct a number of interviews with staff as well as members of our school and parish community. On the final afternoon of their visit they will meet with staff to share with us their recommendations and commendations. Once we receive their report, we will then come together to develop our Long Range Plan based on the Team's recommendations as the final step in re-accreditation.

We ask for your prayers as we complete this process. We are thankful for the many efforts of the staff, school parents and parishioners who assisted with this process over the last year and a half, as well as those who have volunteered to be interviewed next week. In addition, we want to thank Home and School for providing meals and snacks for the team. We truly are grateful to be surrounded by such caring and dedicated people.
