The Playing Field

The Playing Field is a daycare center in Madison which cares for and educates children experiencing homelessness right alongside children from more advantaged backgrounds. Their unique model is an important step toward minimizing the disparity between Madison's children and will have amazing

benefits for children from both groups. During Catholic Schools Week (January 29-February 3) we will be doing a service project of organizing small boxes of necessary items for homeless families whose very young children are experiencing homelessness at this time.

All students are asked to bring in \$1.00 towards the purchase of gas cards and grocery cards. (We welcome any additional donations above the requested \$1.00 for this purchase.)

We are asking families to bring in the following suggested donations by grade level

OR

contribute to any category that best suits your family budget:

Kindergarten and 1st Grade: Toiletries, such as travel size soaps, shampoos, razors, toothpaste, toothbrushes, comb/brush

2nd Grade: Kids' socks (new), sizes baby-5 year old

3rd Grade: Kids' underpants (new), sizes 2-5 year old

4th Grade: Disposable diapers, all sizes, small package

5th Grade: Laundry pods or quarters for laundromats

6th & 7th Grade: A bath towel, or a hand towel or washcloths

8th Grade: Non-perishable healthy snack items, boxed juices, small package of wipes

Other suggested items needed: travel pillows
