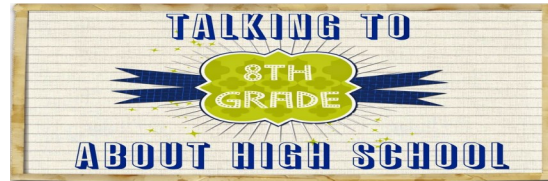

## Madison Mallards Tickets

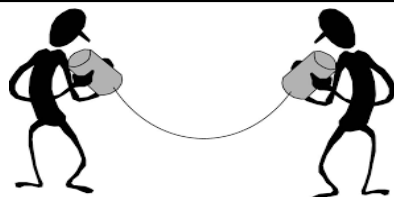
